Place: Local library's garden

Date: 25-05-2024

Budget: 200Euro

Mode: Face to face meeting

Target group: Parents with smaller kids, youth, adults, elderly, whoever is interested and is creative and interested in spending a nice afternoon in great company, promoting good habit of upcycling.

Collaboration: The library as the hosting partner will take care of the event and it's guests, involving volunteers to help with organising and hosting the event. Main partner will be the Town Hall, which is going to fund the event. There will also be a few local artists willing to help and teach participants with creating.

Goals: To show an easy and fun activity for all ages allowing to make something beautiful and useful from resources that cannot be reused (some papers are not suitable for recycling because of the paint used for printing). It is going to encourage people to realise how much paper isn't really recyclable and that there is another option for using it instead of throwing it out.

Resources: old newspapers, notebooks, damaged books wood glue dyes water blenders drainers bowls to mix the ingredients mixing instruments cloths to dry the pulp

Dissemination: An article will be published on the local newspaper (paper or electronic version) along with posts with photos on partner's social media accounts.

Brief description: During the event, participants are going to use old paper scraps and unused paper materials to create a paper mache figurines, sculptures and decorations. There will be workshops organised by local artists that will teach how to make specific things, but we are counting on everyone's creativity as well to create something they will cherish and that will bring smile on their faces while reusing

materials they most likely already had at home. Everyone will be free to take their creations home with them to give them another life and prolong the use of the materials.
